As a result of Staffing NJ PAC's active campaign contributions in 2007, the NJSA Legislative Committee was able to accelerate its program of reaching out in 2008 to not only candidates supported by the PAC in 2007 but also other state assembly and senate officeholders. Our special thanks to Bob Earl of Express Employment Professionals for his many visits representing NJSA in this effort!



The Legislative Committee's primary approach was to present the staffing industry in a more "localized" context for the elected representative. Most were not aware of the actual magnitude of the staffing industry impact BOTH at the state level and at their county level. NJSA shared staffing industry employment data for their individual county. NJSA also supplied a list of NJSA member offices by county for constituent services offices to use in referring citizens to employment resources.

The Legislative Committee participated actively in working with NJDOLWD on the Family Leave Insurance regulations... a place at the table the staffing industry would not have had without its active legislative program.

To expand its outreach further, the Legislative Committee even presented an industry overview to the Hispanic Legislative Caucus, contributing to what was reported to be one of their "best" meetings.
